2. What current procedures do you have in place such as confirmation of payee against fraud?

Validation and due diligence checks are performed on all suppliers before any set-ups or amendments are actioned. If any of these checks fail, the set-up or amendment does not take place.

The organization has a variety of financial controls in place which are designed to prevent fraud. These controls are reviewed and tested regularly as part of internal and external audit activity, as well as being subject to periodic reviews by the Trust's anti-fraud specialist. The setup/amendment will go through further verification checks conducted by the Trust's shared business service partner. It is not the Trust's practice, on the advice of the Anti-Fraud Specialist, to go into detail regarding specific fraud controls in place.
