## **RESPONSE**

St Helens and Knowsley Teaching Hospitals NHS Trust and Southport and Ormskirk Hospital NHS Trust became a single legal entity known as Mersey and West Lancashire Teaching Hospitals NHS Trust on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2023, as such parts of the response may be provided in two sections relating to the hospital sites of each of the legacy organisations.

Moisturisers are advised to be used as often as required depending on severity e.g. tds – qds. A thick layer of moisturizer needs to be applied within three minutes of bathing or showering.

2. What advice does your hospital's dermatology department issue to patients with eczema regarding the amount of steroid cream / ointment that should be applied to patients?

Fingertip unit (FTU) is provided depending on the affected sites (written information is also provided in some cases).
