- 3 to identify the level of detail required by the applicant is not possible in reasonable timeframe therefore cost of compliance exemption applies. It is not a case of filtering data by keyword or eClass code so would require someone involved in the procedures to identify from tens of thousands of lines of data, all items involved in each procedure. Procurement are unable to quantify how long this would take.
