This allows multiple members of staff to update case progression at the same time and allows us to generate real-time stats on service performance.</p>

containing the combined ME-1 Part A&B forms in word document format. The MEOs will pre-populate all required information for ME scrutiny, and the MEs will then add their scrutiny and sign off the case when completed. These are managed within a secure G: drive to ensure that access is controlled, and the community cases adhere to their separate governance restrictions.

Our system supports ME reviews and Community death reviews – Neonate deaths are very low in number for our area and are automatically referred to the coroner, which bypasses ME jurisdiction. We raise SJRs via the Trust escalation route, but we are not involved in their completion, as the ME service is independent. Further clarification on QAP reviews are sought to respond to this questions.
